



HIRE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Charges.** Hire charges are ex works, shown exclusive of collection and/or delivery charges. Delivery and/or collection charges are shown separately. All charges are shown exclusive of VAT.
- Insurance.** All hire items must be insured by the customer to the full value of their replacement, plus the hire charge & an extra charge for the loss of hire whilst repairs are carried out or replacements are obtained, and extra costs placed upon us. The insurance shall commence from the moment the Hire Items are delivered, until they are collected. If the hirer arranges transport themselves, the insurance shall run from the moment the hirer's hauliers collect the scenery until the moment they return it.
- Hire Period.** The period of hire is shown on the Advice Note. Hire items must always be returned on the day as shown on the Advice Note. The period of hire ends only when all items are actually accepted back by us (See Section 5). The hire period must not be extended without prior agreement.
- Late Returns (Extended Hire).** The Hirer is responsible for ensuring all hired items are returned. Where we arrange transport, the hirer ensuring that all items are loaded onto the transport will discharge this responsibility. All hire goods returned after the hire period will incur charges based on full weeks rental for each week, or part of week that the hire items are late. Extra hire charges do not qualify for discounts. Extended hire (Retentions) must be agreed, during the current hire period, to enable us to check availability and to minimise extra hire charges.
- Damages/Breakages.** The hirer will undertake to keep all hire items in good condition. On return, any damaged goods will be retained in their returned condition for 7 days, to enable any inspection by yourselves or your insurance company. After 7 days they will be repaired or replaced entirely at our discretion. In all cases, the full cost of repair will be invoiced to the customer together with an additional charge to cover loss of hire for up to three weeks. This charge to be based on full weeks rental charges excluding any discounts. The customer should check that their insurance as above covers this point. In the event of a total loss the maximum claim will be the replacement value, the full hire charge and loss of hire and costs to us. All broken pieces must be returned with the hire items and at the hirers expense.
- Modifications.** Prior permission must be obtained to alter in any way our hire items. This includes painting and re-upholstering. If this clause is waived by prior agreement – the details will be added on to the advice note. Any items returned in such a modified way without prior authorisation will be treated as in Section 5.
- Identification Marks.** The hirer will not remove, cover up or deface our name plates or identification labels which indicate our ownership of the hire goods.
- Payment.** First payment 1/3rd Hire Charge with order. Second Payment 1/3rd Payable one month before delivery. Final Payment 1/3rd payable 30 days after final performance. Delays in payment will incur an interest charge of 5% per month. These conditions can vary for new, overseas, and last minute orders, as per Advice note/Quotation.
- Charges for Cancellation.** If the hirer wishes to cancel the booking, Perry Scenic will attempt to re-hire the hire items to another organisation for the contract dates. Should this not be possible, charges will be incurred by the hirer as follows: one third of hire Fee if before two months of hire date; two thirds of hire fee if between one and two months of hire date; full hire fee if within one month of hire date.
- Liability.** Perry Scenic Limited will make every endeavour to supply all ordered items on time. We will not be liable for any delays caused by any circumstances beyond our reasonable control. We will not be liable for any indirect loss, loss of business, fees or expenses because of late delivery, non-delivery or unsuitability of any part of the hire goods. The hirer uses the hire items supplied by Perry Scenic at their own risk. It is the responsibility of the hirer to use the hired goods responsibly, professionally, in the manner for which they are designed, adhering to all health and safety regulations applicable to each individual location. Any risk assessment is the responsibility of the hirer., Perry Scenic Ltd accepts no contingent liability for consequential loss of profits or other damages caused by miss use of the hired goods. All items are checked and leave our workshop in good working condition and it is responsibility of the hirer to maintain good working order and to report to use immediately any damage during transit and usage of hired goods.
